Comments or questions requiring detailed discussion shall be assigned to staff to report back to the Board as a matter of business at a subsequent meeting. (Government Code § 54954.2.).

5. Board to receive an update on Resolution 2026-03, and order levying Assessment Call No. 35 based upon Operation and Maintenance Valuation Assessment Roll dated July 21, 1992.
